**NOTICE OF (I) OBJECTION DEADLINE AND (II) FINAL HEARING
ON DEBTORS' "MOTION FOR AN ORDER FIXING TIME FOR FILING
PROOFS OF CLAIM, APPROVING CLAIM FORMS, AND APPROVING
MANNER AND FORM OF NOTICE"**

On March 6, 2014, the Roman Catholic Church of the Diocese of Gallup (“RCCDG”) and the Bishop of the Roman Catholic Church of the Diocese of Gallup (the “**Arizona Entity**,” and collectively with RCCDG, the “**Debtors**”) filed the “Motion for an Order Fixing Time for Filing Proofs of Claim, Approving Claim Forms, and Approving Manner and Form of Notice” [Dkt. No. 192] (the “**Motion**”).

In the Motion, the Debtors request that the Court enter an order that, among other things requires anyone asserting a claim against the Debtors, be required to file a claim with the Court by a date set by the Court. The Debtors have proposed that such a deadline be set 120 days after service of the notice of the claims bar date. The Motion also asks the Court to approve a process for providing notice of the bar date to file claims to parties by mail and by posting notice in various locations including missions and parishes, and in other public locations such as Navajo Chapter Houses. The Debtors also request that the Posted Notice¹ be published in certain newspapers by paid ads, and that a press release be read as a public service announcement. The Motion also asks the Court to approve the form of notice that will be distributed which advises parties as to the process for filing claims. In addition, the Motion provides that any creditor (including any Tort Claimant) who fails to timely file a Tort Claim Form or Other Claims Form on or before the Claims Bar Date may be prohibited from participating in the Reorganization

Cases with respect to voting on a plan of reorganization, distribution under a plan of reorganization, or in any other regard.

Any party who objects to the Motion must file its objection with the Clerk of the Bankruptcy Court, Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 500 Gold Ave. SW, Tenth Floor, Albuquerque, NM 87102 (or P.O. Box 546, Albuquerque, NM 87103) within twenty-one (21) days after the date of mailing of this notice, plus three days as a result of service of this notice by mail, for a total of twenty-four (24) days (or on or before **March 31, 2014**) and serve a copy of the objection on Susan G. Boswell, Quarles & Brady LLP, One South Church Avenue, Suite 1700, Tucson, Arizona 85701. If objections are timely filed, they will be considered at a final hearing to be held on **April 9, 2014 at 9:00 a.m.** before the Honorable David T. Thuma, United States Bankruptcy Judge, Dennis Chavez Federal Building and United States Courthouse, 13th Floor, 500 Gold Ave., S.W., Albuquerque, New Mexico, 87102. If no objections are timely filed, an order granting the Motion will be presented to the Court without further notice and the hearing may be vacated.
