

Gallup Vocations Office

The undersigned individuals acknowledge and agree to the following:

1. The Gallup Vocations Office is providing an opportunity for retreatants to participate in a retreat sponsored by the Gallup Vocations Office. This will result in the retreatants traveling to and visiting places which the Gallup Vocations Office has decided should be part of the retreat, and will be a benefit to the retreatants (see attached schedule of activities). The undersigned must understand that the level of supervision provided will be of a general nature. When retreatants are in their rooms, for example, it is not possible to provide constant supervision. Curfews, however, will be enforced. It is important for the retreatants and parents to acknowledge and accept that this is the type of supervision that will be provided by the Vocations Office.
2. Additionally, the type of event the retreatant is participating in requires travel and overnight accommodations, for example, travel to the high desert trail system, and the Little Sisters of the Poor. The parents and retreatants must accept such common risks associated with the retreat activities before the travel begins. By signing this agreement, the undersigned parent and or retreatant agree not to hold the Gallup Vocations Office, or the Diocese of Gallup liable for any dangers associated with travel and retreat activities.
3. The retreatant is expected to comply with all the expectations outlined in the Code of Conduct to be verbally presented to the retreatants upon registrations on Friday August 1st, and to comply with the safety requests of adult chaperones at all times. Failure to do so will result in appropriate disciplinary action, including, but not limited to, asking the retreatant to leave the retreat. To the extent that the undersigned retreatant is a minor, it is understood that the parents will assume all risks, and further, the parent will agree to indemnify the Gallup Vocations Office for any claim arising out of the trip or based in whole or in part in a failure of adequate supervision brought by or on behalf of the retreatant now or in the future.
